INTRODUCTION

This list supplements The Timor Collection, Darwin. List of Holdings (as of 30 June 1982) which was prepared some months ago. Books and articles acquired for the Timor Collection between July and December 1982 are given, as well as a list (as of 31 December 1982) of holdings omitted from the 30 June 1982 list such as newspaper articles, maps, audio recordings, posters and photographs.

The Timor Collection is being formed with the hope that it will eventually provide, in the nearest Australian urban centre to that island, a comprehensive collection of material relating to Timor which could be of use to the Timorese people and to others with an interest in Timor.

The Timor Collection is, for the present, the private property of Kevin Sherlock, 6 Lampe Street, Fannie Bay, Darwin, Northern Territory, 5790, Australia, but it is intended that the collection will, within the next few years, be lodged as a unit within the Northern Territory Library Service where the public will have access to it. The Director of that Library Service has stated that he would be happy to accept the collection and would be quite willing to keep the collection as a separate and distinct unit.

In reference to newspaper holdings, the only reasonably complete set from the daily press in The Timor Collection is of the local Darwin paper The Northern Territory News. However, even this has one huge gap, that of the year 1980. I was absent from Darwin for most of that year, having gone to Portugal for further research about Timor, and had been unable to make a reliable arrangement for copies of articles about Timor appearing in that paper to be kept aside for me. Photocopies of some items for that year were later passed on to me, but they were not of a good enough quality to be considered as file copies for the collection, and I shall attempt to arrange for better copies to be made. I hope to arrange for copies of the newspaper items which appear during my absence in Macau later this year to be kept for the collection.

Purchases for the collection are being kept to a minimum at the moment in order to finance my visit to Macau. I shall be in Macau from mid-July 1983 for a period of anything from 6 to 12 months, depending on finance, in order to research both published and unpublished mid-19th Century to mid-20th Century material relating to Timor in the libraries and archives. I shall also see what items can be purchased or transcribed there for adding to The Timor Collection, Darwin.

The next supplement will not appear until after my return from Macau and the arrival in Darwin of whatever material I am able to collect there, so one might expect to see the next supplement by the end of 1984.

Permission is unconditionally granted for copies to be made of this list. An asterisk (*) indicates that a photocopy only is held.

Dear John,

Please find enclosed a copy of The Timor Collection, Darwin - Acquisitions list July-December 1982, and Holdings of Maps, Records, Posters, Photos and Press Items (as of 31 December 1982), this being a supplement to The Timor Collection, Darwin - List of Holdings (as of 30 June 1982), a copy of which I hope I sent to you some weeks ago (I'm 99% certain, though I didn't make a definite note of it; let me know if I didn't send one).

May I ask a favour of you? Originally I was going to work straight through until I leave for Macau in mid-July. My employer gives a free return air ticket to Sydney or Melbourne every two years, but I cannot have this credited towards overseas travel or use it at termination of employment. Therefore I decided to have 4 weeks in Canberra mid-February to mid-March, but have now decided to make it 3 weeks only with the first week in Canberra just catching up on references during the past year, then go on to Melbourne and Sydney for a few days in each. However, I shall not be going to libraries in Melbourne and Sydney! I want to use that time to make contacts with members of the Timorese communities and to get together with people such as yourselves. I want to find out what the communities are doing, how they are doing, and, owing to the nature of my own work, meet some people who would have some interest in my work, hopefully bringing about some two-way traffic in information, ideas, suggestions, etc.

I'm flying to Canberra on Sunday, 18th Feb., and intend to travel on to Melbourne on Saturday, 26th Feb. I've left the date of my travel from Melbourne to Sydney open, but would want to be in Sydney by Monday, 7th March, at the latest. Owing to my coming trip to Macau I'm trying to avoid going to any great expense. Would it be possible for you to arrange somewhere quite cheap for me to stay? I understand that João Gonçalves is one of the official with the Timorese Association of Australia, and, if you know him well, I would be grateful if you could let him know that I would like to meet with some members of the Association who might be interested in the same line of research that I'm involved in, including anyone involved in the production of community newsletters and cultural aspects. I'll be writing to José Ricardo at Geelong, and I hope to spend a few hours with him, but I don't know whether it will be in Geelong or Melbourne.

Hoping to hear from you soon as to what might be possible,
