Dear John and Maurice,

As promised in my letter of October 14th, here is a list of recent anthropological literature about East Timor. Items included relate to social anthropology, ethnography, linguistics, oral literature, and general travel. I have not included any items published before the 1960's, for, with few exceptions, holdings of Portuguese language items in Australian libraries are very limited. I have limited the geographical coverage of the listed items to East Timor proper, without Oe-Cussi, and the groups just over the border in West Timor. There is a considerable amount of literature about the Atoni (Dawan) who occupy most of West Timor, but I have left this out of the enclosed list. Monash University would probably be the best library in Victoria to try for most of the items. Some of the items included are unpublished but they are worth taking note of in case the authors do publish something in the future on the subject and you can keep a watch out for their names.

Now I'll just do a brief run through the list with a few notes.

- * Antonio de Almeida occupies over 5 pages in the master list, writing since the 1940's on physical and social anthropology, ethnography, and archaeology. His address is:- Prof. Dr. António de Almeida, Secretário Perpétuo, Sociedade de Geografia de Lisboa, Portas de Santo Antão, 100, LISBOA-2, Portugal.
- * Apontamentos The Portuguese Embassy would probably give permission for a photocopy from that issue of the Boletim in the National Library.
- * Barata. This series is from the Junta de Investigações do Ultramar (J.I.U.), and that and any others listed herein from the J.I.U. would previously have been available from the Centro de Documentação Científica Ultramarina, Rua Jau, 47-, LISBOA-2, Portugal, however, since the Ministério do Ultramar became the Ministério da Cooperação I don't know what the current title of the Centro is, but the Portuguese authorities should be able to tell you .
- * Bernova. I've been told that one can wait for ages to get any literature from Moscow, and I have been waiting for a reply since September 1976.
- * Louis Berthe is now dead but his widow Claudine Friedberg (who see) is still publishing much material. His work may be available at Monash or ANU.
- * The Campagnolos have been busy preparing a new work on the Fataluku (Los Palos-Tutuala region). Probably back in Paris now at 194 Rue Château des Rentiers, 75013, PARIS, France.
- * Campos, C., and Campos, V. See under Barata.
- * Capell has now retired. His address is 5/276 Pacific Highway, LINDFIELD, N.S.W. 2070. Knows the Campagnolos. You should have no trouble finding his works in libraries.
- * Carmo. See under Barata.
- * Cinatti. Full name is Ruy Cinatti Vaz Monteiro Gomes, which name some of his writings carry, but known generally as Ruy Cinatti. Writing since about 1950 on botany, ethnography, social anthropology, poetry, and has about 2 pages in the master list. He and Almeida are the current Portuguese "grand old men" of Timorese studies. Never had a reply from him, but his address is:- Eng. Ruy Cinatti, Museu de Etnologia do Ultramar, Av. da Ilha da Madeira, LISBOA-3, Portugal.


- * Clamagirand. Most of it should be available at Monash. Write to her at the address given for either of the institutions in the relevant magazines.

- * Cowan. Try Monash.

- * Landman. You already have it.
- * Meneses. Universidade técnica de Lisboa, Rua do Quelhas 6, LISBOA, Portugal, may be able to help you.
- * Metzner. Monash may have items 1 and 2, but unlikely. Item 3 came out in last few weeks. Write to the Administrative Secretary, Development Studies Centre, 'A' Block, Australian National University, P.O. Box 4, CANBERRA, A.C.T. 2600. Is centred on Baucau-Viqueque area.
- * Momsen. Try Public Library and second-hand dealers.
- * Oliveira. See address for Almeida.
- * Pascoal. Priest who published a great deal in Seara, 2 pages in master list. Some republished in this book. If you write to Barbosa & Xavier Lda., Rua Gabriel Pereira de Castro 31c, BRAGA, Portugal, you may have better luck than I have had (I wrote in April)!
- * Pequena Clifford Morris or Jill Jolliffe may know someone with this or a later edition.
- * Portela. Probably not held in Australian libraries. Library should be able to locate publishers name for you in current serials annual.
